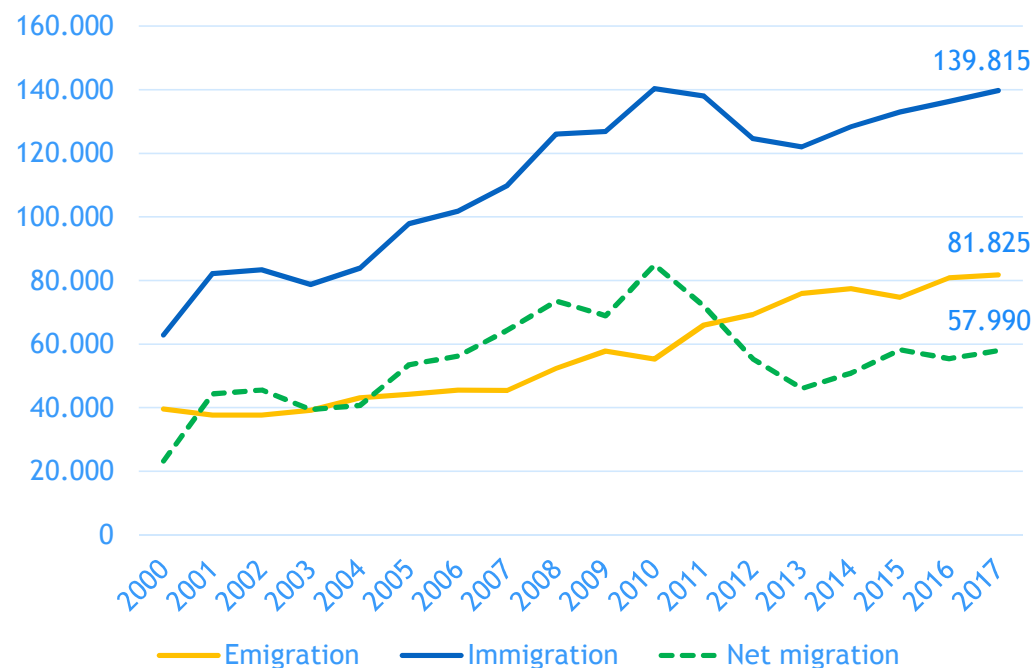

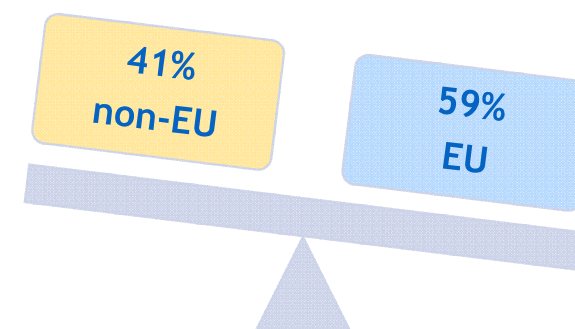

Annual migration flows to and from BE



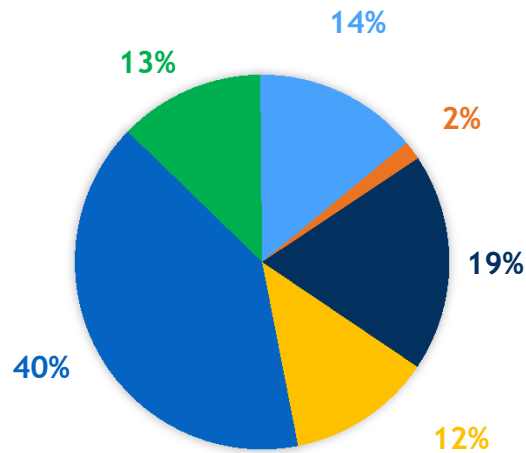
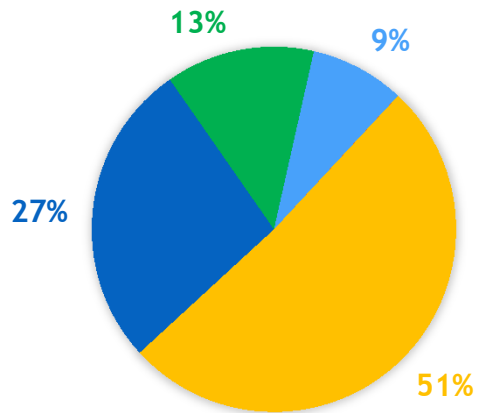
141.951 immigrations registered in BE in 2018



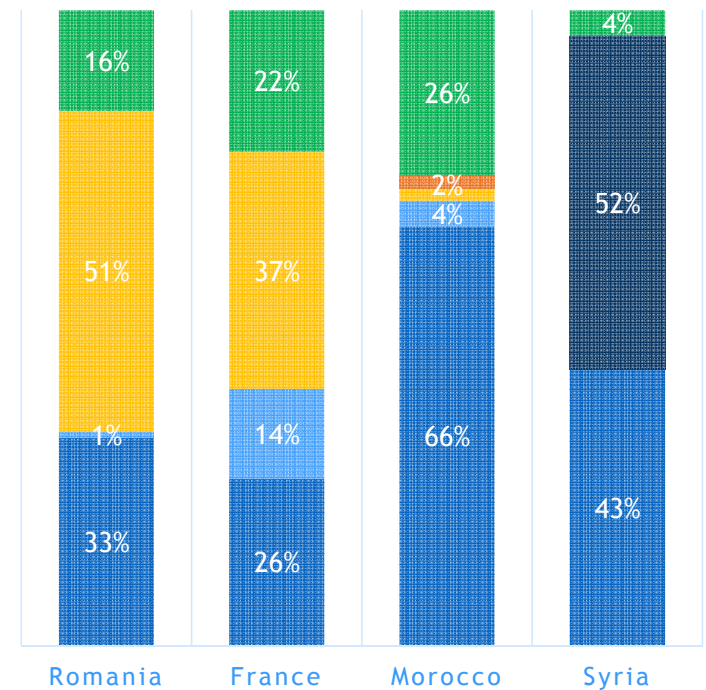
Reasons for migration to Belgium

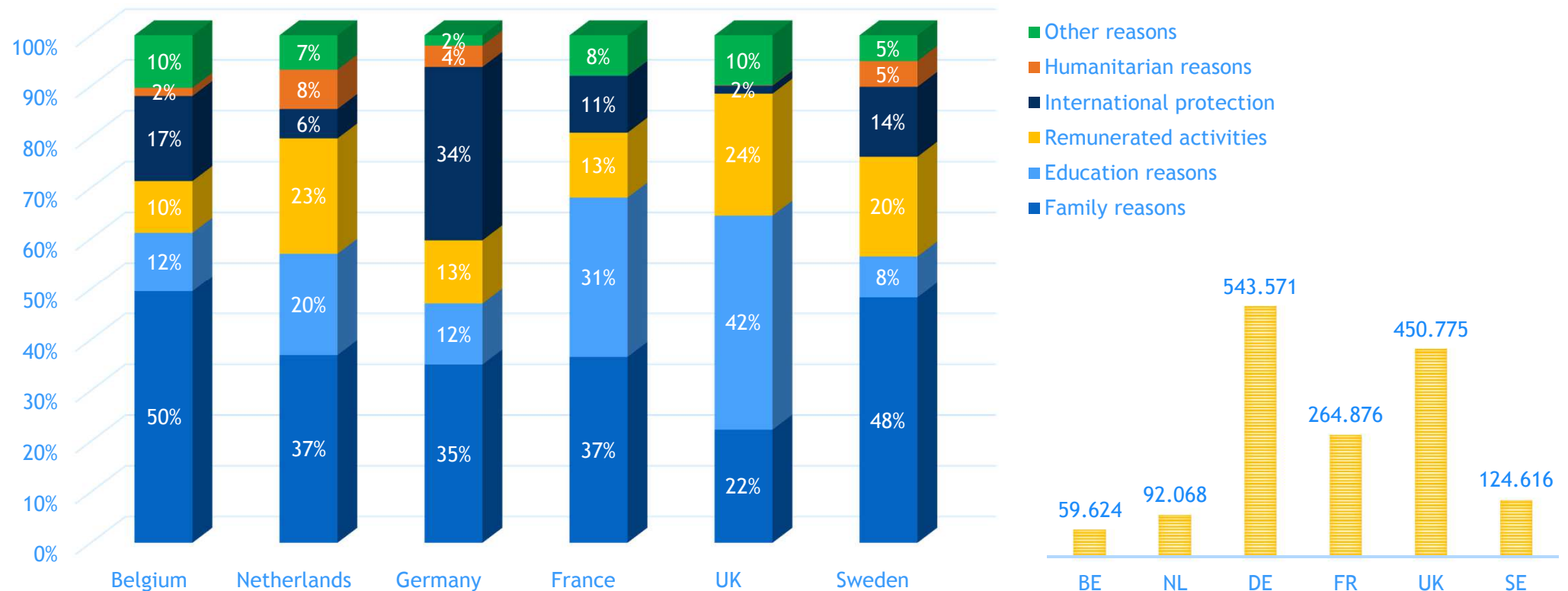

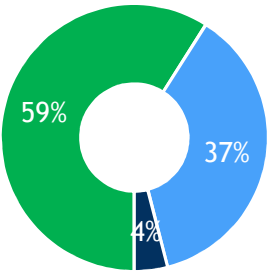

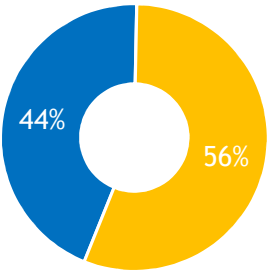

By relationship in 2017



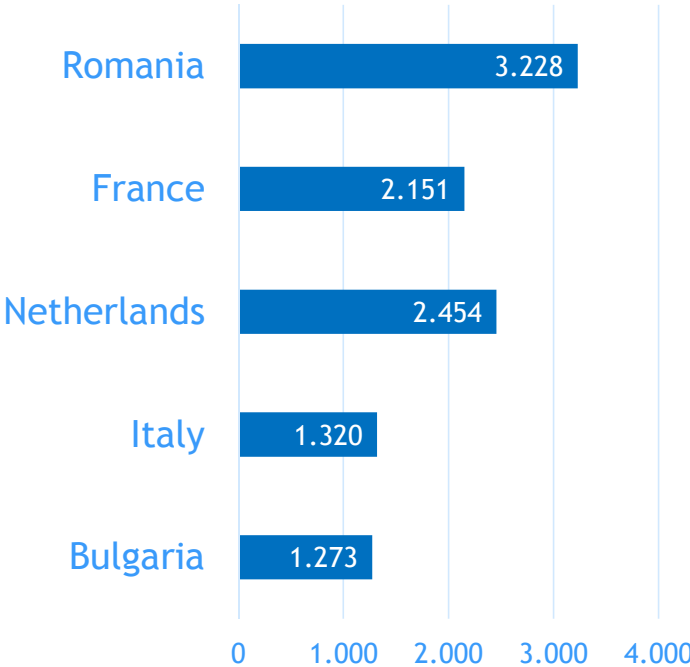

By nationality in 2018

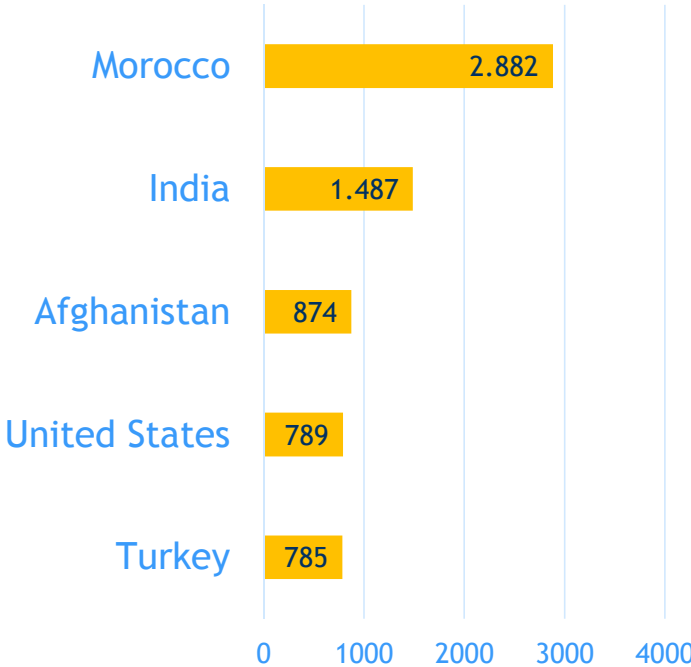

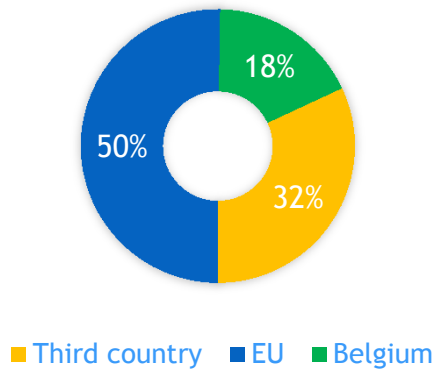

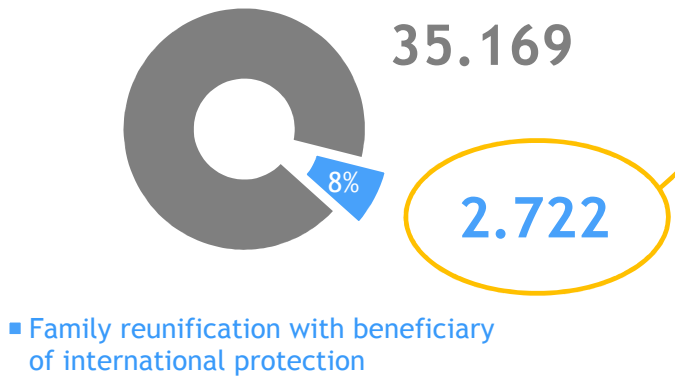

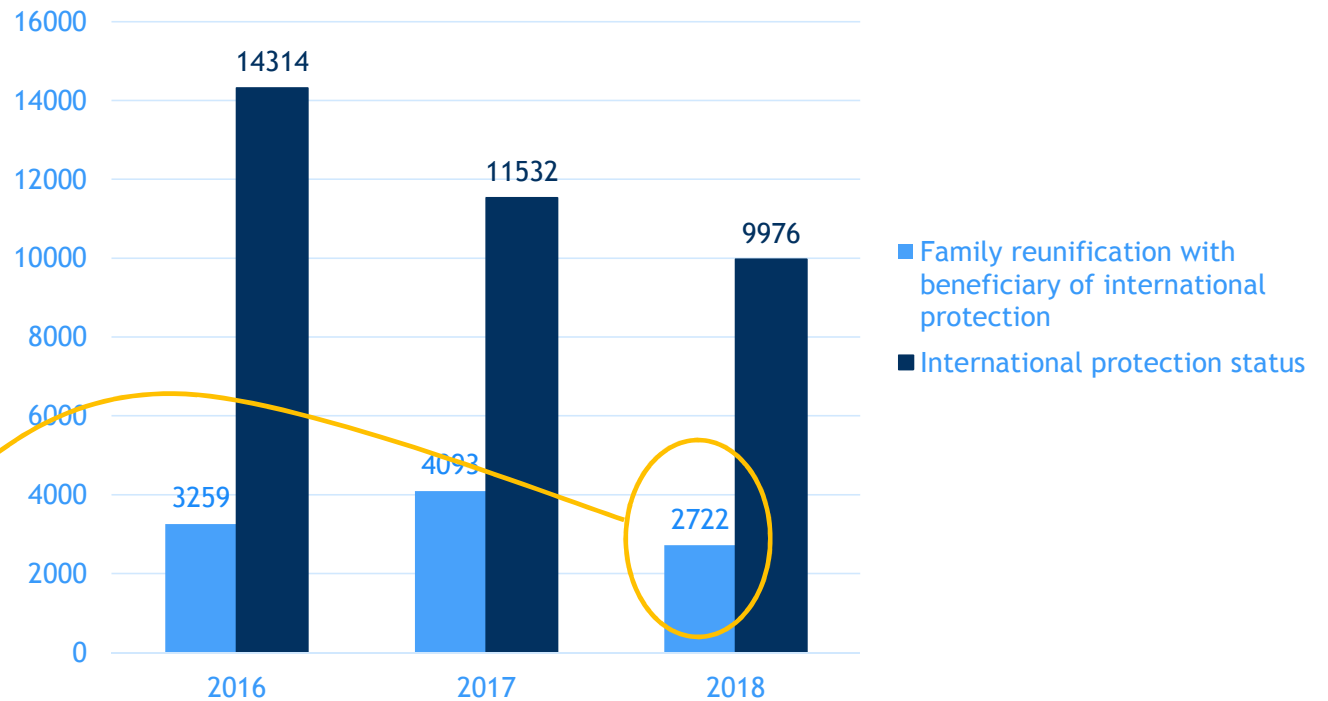

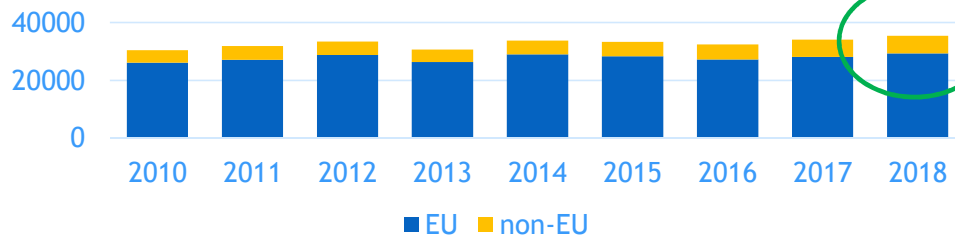

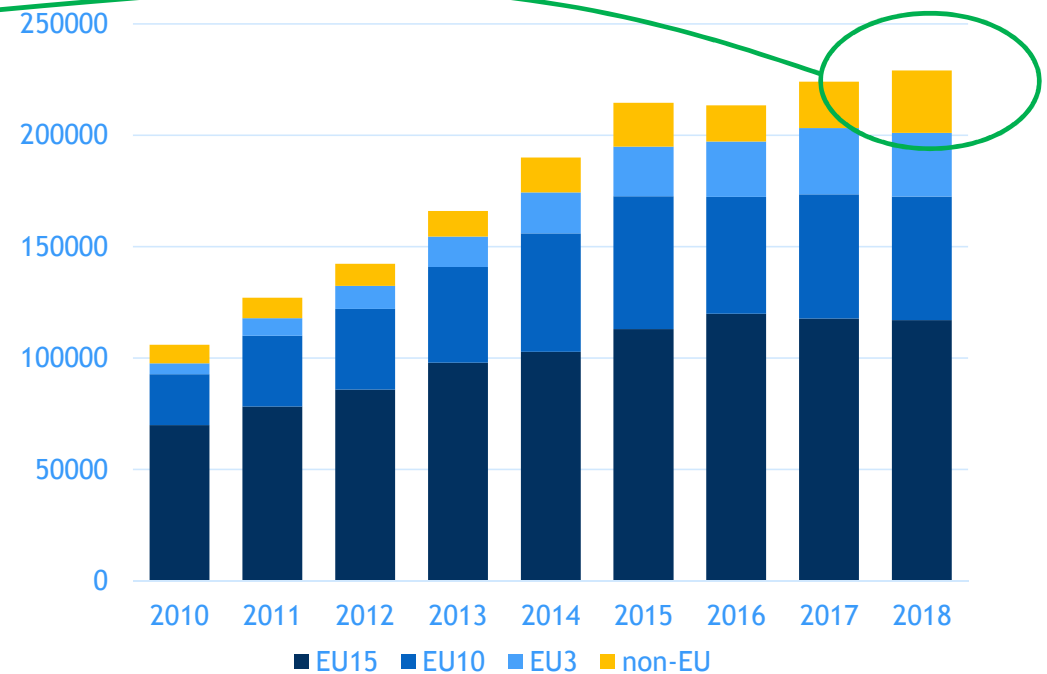

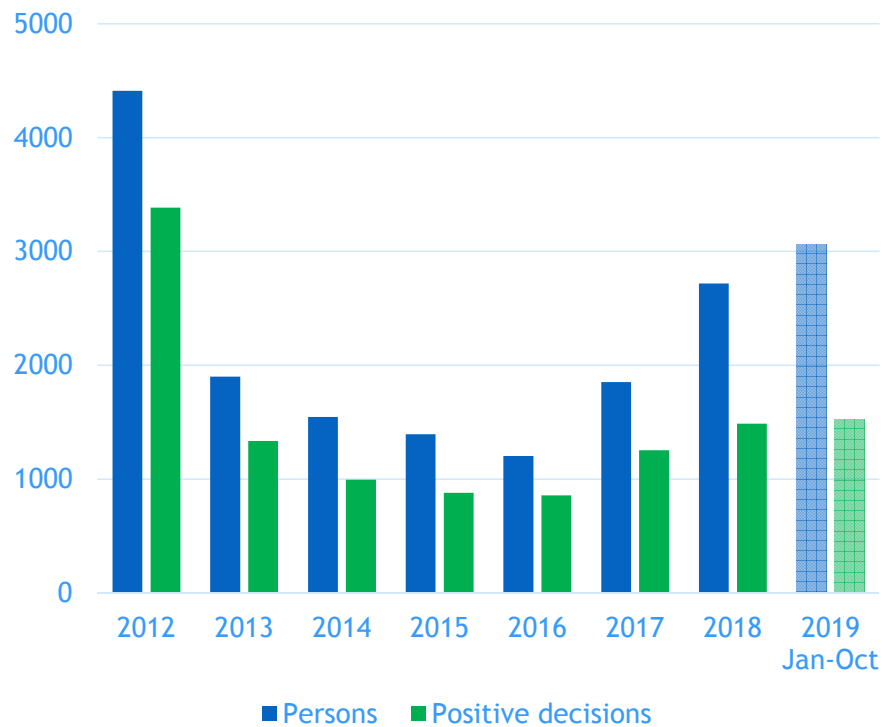

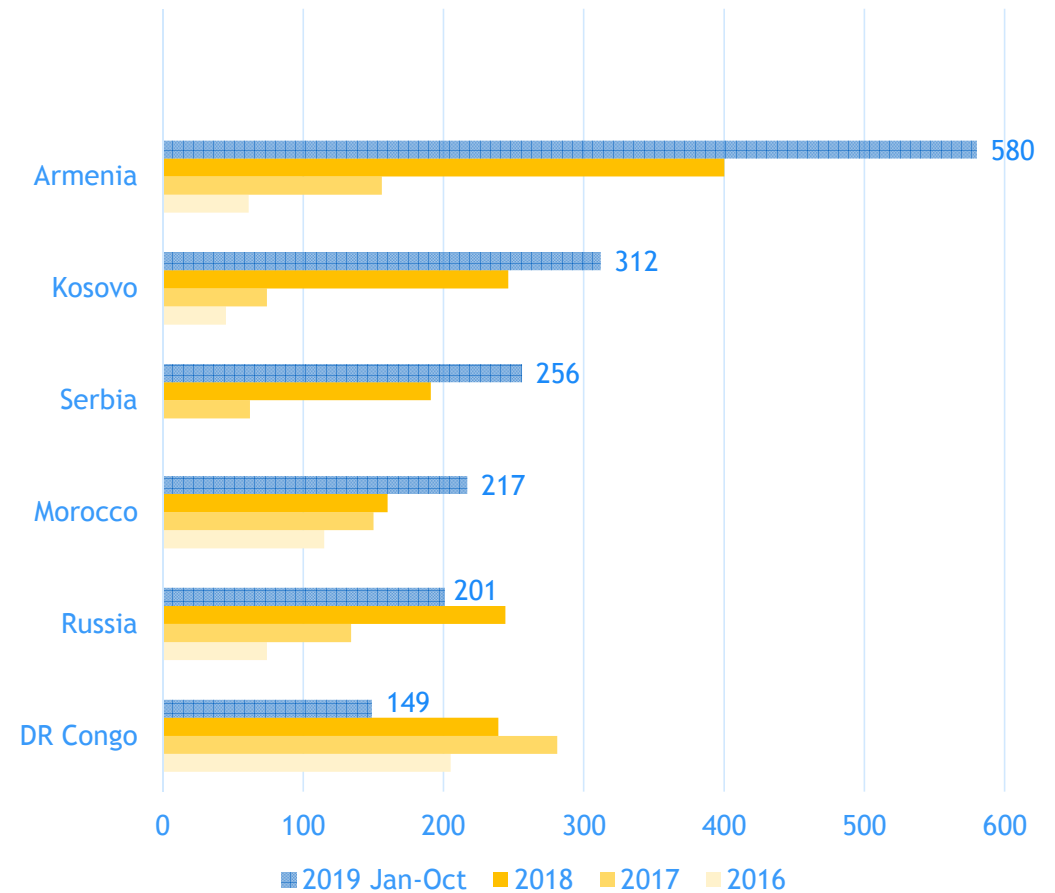

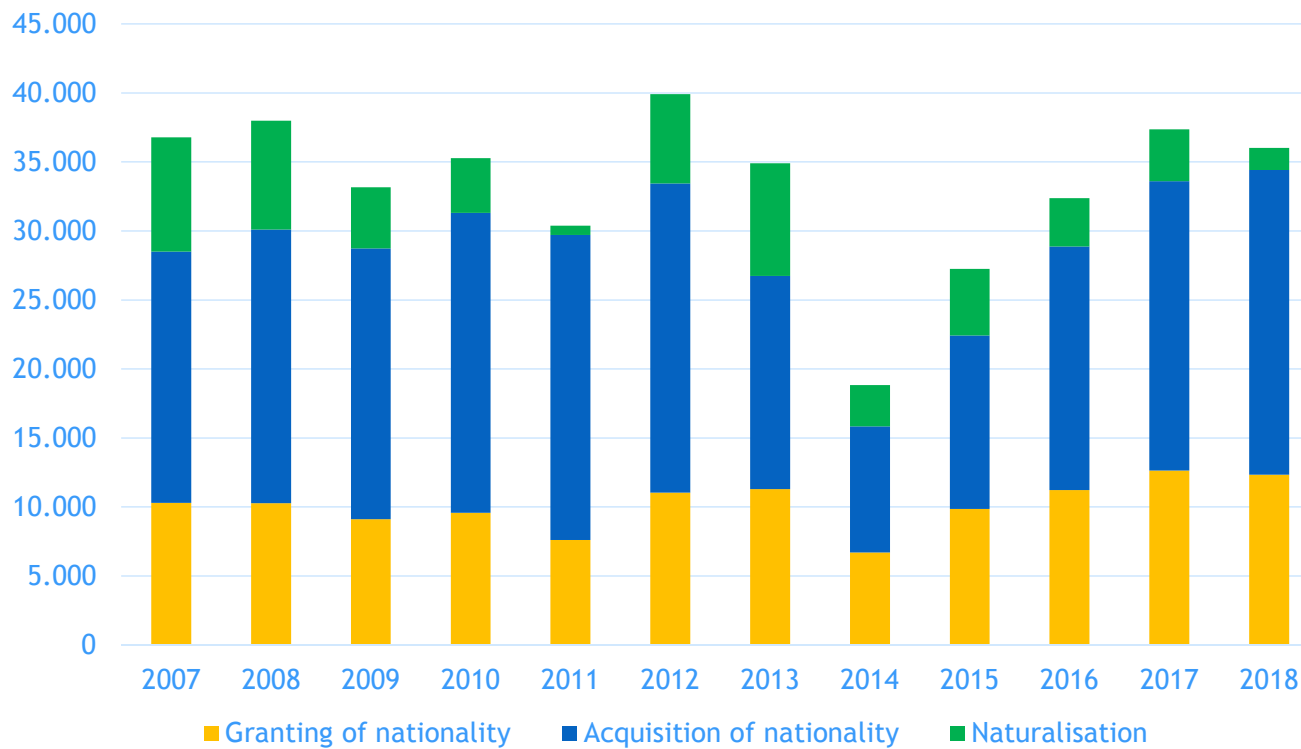
