6. TRANSPORTATION & OTHER LOCAL INFO

The city of Belgrade is divided into three zones when it comes to public transport:

- Zone A- to which the following municipalities belong: Novi Beograd, Zemun, Stari grad, Savski venac, Vožvodac, Čukarica, Vračar, Rakovica, Palilula, Zvezdara, Surčin, Gročka (north of route 347 Vrčin-Zaklopača);
- Zone B- to which the following municipalities belong: Lazarevac, Mladenovac, Obrenovac, Barajevo, Sopot, Gročka (south of route 347 Vrčin-Zaklopača) ;
- Zone C- covers all 17 Belgrade municipalities.

Of the three mentioned zones of public transportation, Zone A is relevant taking into account the location of the conference. Tickets for public transportation can be purchased by sms message. The cost of tickets depends on the zone and time limitations. More information about cost of public transport:

We recomend taking these lines of public transportation:

- From Republic Square- bus lines 26 (ID number of bus stop -532) or 27 (ID number of bus stop - 603) to bus stop Tehnički Fakulteti (ID number of bus stop-584);
- From Airport Nikola Tesla – bus line 72 (ID number of bus stop -2303) to the bus stop Zeleni venac (ID number of bus stop - 1049), then bus EKO 1 (ID number to the bus stop - 360) and then to bus stop Tehnički fakulteti (ID number of bus stop - 584);
- From Airport Nikola Tesla – bus line A1(ID number of bus stop - 2303) to the bus stop Fontana (ID number of bus stop - 456), then bus line 72 or 75 bus line to the bus stop Zeleni venac (ID number of bus stop - 1049), then bus EKO 1 (ID number of bus stop – 360) to the bus stop Tehnički fakulteti (ID number of bus stop - 584)
